For my family, the answer is simple: we are called to a mission.

If you've been around City Church for any length of time, you know we are laser focused on our mission: to help people find their way to God from where they are.



Why "Here. For Good."?

Permanence has been a focus of prayer and a goal throughout this last year for City Church. The original focal point of this prayer was to be a financially self-sustaining church by the end of 2021 so that no matter where we were gathering, we could continue to be a church IN and FOR the city. Surprisingly, stats show that less than 6% of church plants make it to a financially self-sustaining place by year 5. I am so humbled to celebrate that we are ON TRACK to be self-sustaining by the new year! WOW. Just wow. In addition to our goal of permanence through financial sustainability, the option of purchasing our existing rental property has opened up alongside other property and permanence options. As a result of the opportunities in front of us, through much prayer and wise counsel, we feel led to begin raising an initial down payment of \$1M toward our effort of permanence. Raising these funds allows us to be not only a contender for our current property but also for other opportunities currently in front of us or in the future.



WHAT SHOULD BE.

How are we "Here. For Good." Together?

Purchasing property in Boulder is a massive dream. Our ability to see the vision of a church in and for the city would increase exponentially upon ownership of property. The possibilities are seemingly endless; to leverage a building and property 24/7 for the good of others and the glory of God rather than just a gathering space on the weekends. Imagine a building used as a community center serving the underprivileged in our community. Imagine a local community hub, business center, and coffee shop that leverages profit for missions around the world. Imagine a space for after school programs serving local families in need. Imagine a community park and playground where people can gather, connect, and build community. Imagine a place to serve the homeless, helpless, and marginalized (especially in the more dangerous winter months). Imagine all of this good and more as we listen to the heart of God and put our heart and hands to His good work and mission in our city. Imagine a city that is blown away by the constant expressions of radical generosity flowing out of the people and place of City Church. Imagine all the people in our city (over 93%) who might be skeptical of our beliefs, but blown away by our love. Imagine all the people coming into the family of God as we continue to join God on mission in building His kingdom here in Boulder. There it is. To see heaven more crowded... to see it "in Boulder as it is in Heaven!" Imagine going beyond a church in and for the city. With this opportunity we can be a church "HERE. FOR GOÓD."



NEXT STEPS

Pray

Prayer will always be our first and most important response, not our last resort. Our faith and generosity in this season will not come from our personality or our emotions; it will come from seeking God through prayer. It will come from being with Jesus. Ask God if and what he wants you to give toward the Here. For Good. Campaign. If God doesn't tell you to give, don't. If God tells you to give, do so willingly, joyfully, and boldly as an act of worship!

Reflect


As you pray, we believe the Holy Spirit will speak to you. Take some time to reflect on what the Holy Spirit is saying to you. Create space to be surrendered and available; create space to align with God; ask God to put on your heart what is on His. Once you hear... joyfully obey knowing it's for the glory of God and the good of others!

Respond

Everything Jesus wants to do in and through you, He will do out of the overflow of His relationship with you. We are confident that as intimacy with God increases in our lives, activity will follow with His presence and power. Generosity is an invitation into deeper trust and intimacy with God. This invitation is designed to help us focus on the behaviors and attitudes of our hearts rather than amounts and percentages being evaluated. Engage

Jesus primary call and invitation on our lives is to be with Him; to abide (John 15). We've seen modeled through the life of Jesus what we've come to call the 5% life at City Church.
